→ **General Information**

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), which comes into force on May 25th, 2018, aims to protect the fundamental right to privacy and the protection of personal data of European Union (EU) citizens.

This regulation affects any entity (including websites) that processes EU citizens' personal data. Whether or not you or your business is located in the EU, if you have EU site visitors, or if your marketing campaigns target EU citizens, this affects you.

→ **Data Collection**

Our Website (www.cphclinic.com) is hosted on the Wix.com platform. To be able to communicate with you as a client we collect your email information and content which is stored through Wix.com's data storage, databases and the general Wix.com applications. Wix.com store your data on secure servers behind a firewall. We handle all the information send to us by email with the strictest patient doctor confidentiality. However, any information sent over the internet is subject to interception and should be taken under consideration when sensitive material is included in any email communication.
